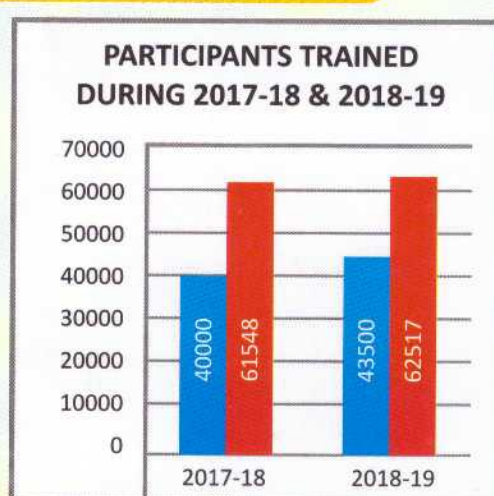
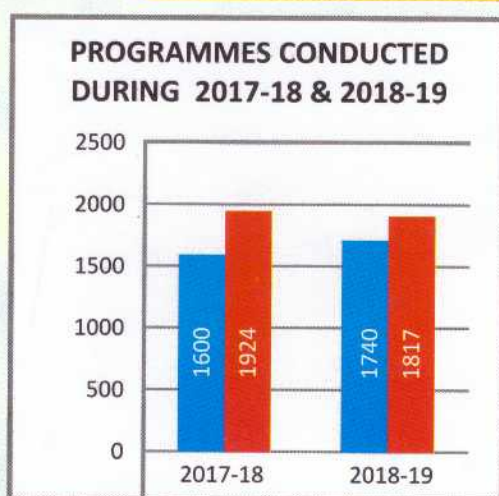
National Council for Cooperative Training (NCCT) is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 under the aegis of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmer's Welfare, Government of India. It is responsible for organizing, directing, monitoring and evaluating the arrangements for cooperative training for the personnel working in the cooperative sector in the country as well as other stakeholders of cooperative movement in the country. The main objective of the NCCT is to organize need based training programmes and facilitate the process of human resource development for cooperatives in the country. It also envisages conducting research in critical areas of cooperative movement.

NCCT has established 20 Training Institutions comprising of Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Cooperative Management, Pune at National Level, Five Regional Institutes of Cooperative Management at Chandigarh, Bangalore, Kalyani, Gandhinagar and Patna. There are 14 Institutes of Cooperative Management located at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Dehradun, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Imphal, Jaipur, Kannur, Lucknow, Madurai, Nagpur, Pune and Thiruvananthapuram. All these RICMs/ICMs are accredited with Centre for Professional Excellence in Cooperative (CPEC) of Bankers' Institute of Rural Development (BIRD), Lucknow.

During the year 2018-19, NCCT exceeded the annual targets both in terms of the number of programmes organised as well as the number of participants who attended these programmes. Against the target of 1740 programmes, NCCT conducted 1817 programmes with an increase of 4% and in respect of participants, NCCT trained 62517 participants against the target of 43500 participants, recording an increase of 44%.

Apart from the regularly organised training programmes, the training units of NCCT also conduct professional courses like PGDM (Agri-Business), MBA, PGDCA, BBA, and Diploma in Rural Management, enabling them to manage cooperative and corporate enterprises. During the year 2018-19, these programmes continued to expand their scope and achieved higher professional excellence.

A total of 51 faculty members passed Certified Trainer for Financial Cooperatives (CTFC) course offered by Centre for Professional Excellence in Cooperatives (C-PEC) BIRD, Lucknow and have become certified trainers for credit cooperatives. Moreover, 37 Faculty Members had so far completed Faculty Development Programme (FDP) at IIM, Ahmedabad.

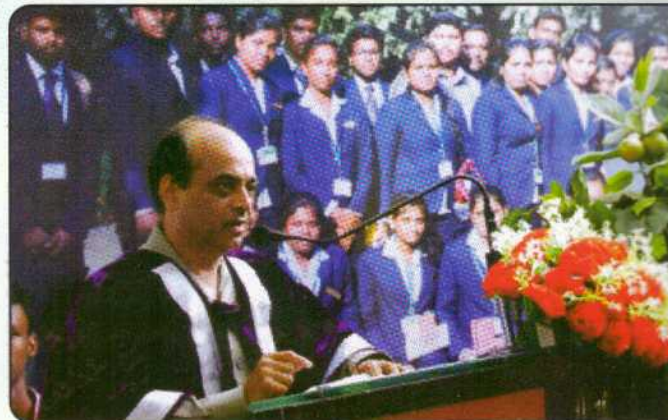

Under the Government of India's Flagship Programme 'Doubling of Farmers' income by 2022', NCCT organised "One day outreach workshop on strategies for Doubling Farmers' Income in the states by 2022" through its Regional Institutes of Cooperative Management (RICMs)/ Institutes of Cooperative Management (ICMs) located all over the country. The units of NCCT i.e. RICM, Bangalore, Kalyani, ICM, Imphal, Hyderabad, Bhopal, Nagpur, Kannur, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Madurai, Dehradun, Lucknow, Thiruvananthapuram organised the above workshop during 30th January, 2019 to 22nd March, 2019. The objective of the workshop was to highlight and discuss on the strategies adopted by different states in this direction. The delegates of the workshop were Successful Cooperatives, Progressive Farmers, PAMs, Members, FPO members, SHGs, Agricultural Scientists, Academicians, Research Scholars, Cooperator etc. Resource Persons made presentations on different issues pertaining to doubling farmers' income during the Technical Session followed by discussions on relevant issues.

Some of the major recommendations for action points which came out from these workshops are as follows:

- Farmers should be sensitized to apply appropriate technology for integration of farm enterprises i.e. crop, livestock, forestry, fishery, etc. to raise income to farmers without degrading socio-economic and ecological balance.
- There is a need to transform Indian Farmers as Agri Entrepreneurs by designing Agri-business Plan, so as to connect farmers directly to market by avoiding middleman.
- E-commerce platform may be introduced for the farmers for outreaching target market (domestic and international).

## MODEL CARBON POSITIVE ECO VILLAGE PROJECT

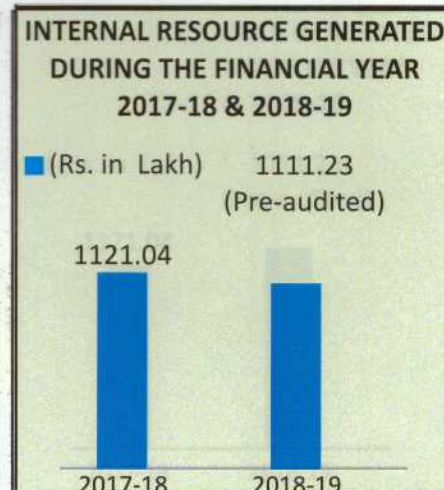
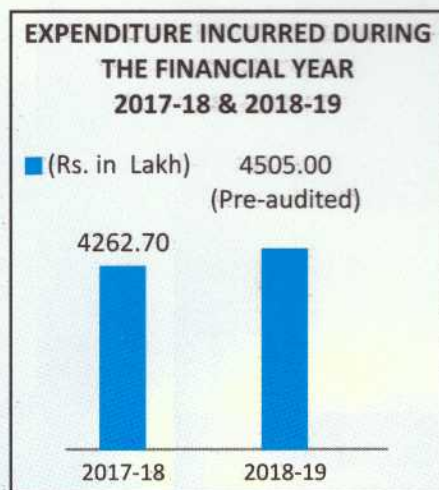
Partnership in training Capacity Building and Institutional Development at Phayeng Village, Imphal West in executing project entitled "Model Carbon Positive Eco Village at Phayeng Manipur" under National Adaptation Fund for climate change, ICM, Imphal through the Department of Environment, Govt. of Manipur has organised training for 21 Women Scheduled Caste Self Help Groups. Altogether 220 members have been trained through various programmes including pre-formation activities, training of group leaders, monitoring and developing of MIS such as preparation of bye-laws, holding of monthly group meeting, support for documentation and opening of bank accounts with the Manipur State Cooperative Bank Ltd. All the 21 Self Help Groups formed by the Institute have opened their accounts and till now 19 group have been linked with the Manipur State Cooperative Bank Ltd.

The Institute conducted various programmes on Accounting, Management, Leadership and other Skill Development Programme for the members. These SHGs are functioning actively after the intervention of the Institute under the collaboration of the Environment Department, Government of Manipur. The women members are given financial literacy, leadership skill, skill development, management skill. They are now participating in exhibitions and other programme arranged by different organizations and empowered socially and economically.
